"Initial search results indicate that cybercriminals intruded on the supporting application system, not on the **Bank Jatim** Core System. In other words, the integrity of customer data is maintained and **bankjatim** customers can remain calm to carry out banking financial transactions," explained Tony.

With this news, Tonny ensured that there were no problems with **bankjatim's** operations and services and that they would continue to run normally. "**bankjatim** also continues to improve the protection of the company's data so that it is not vulnerable to cyber crimes," said Tony.

Customers can also take advantage of **bankjatim** e-channel services such as JConnect mobile banking and JConnect internet banking to perform banking financial transactions quickly, easily and safely.

So far, bankjatim has also mitigated the risk of cyber attacks through collaboration with the National Cyber and Crypto Agency (BSSN) to implement information system security standards. Then at this time **bankjatim** has coordinated with various related parties for the investigation and resolution of the problem.

Furthermore, **bankjatim** will coordinate with customers to ensure services to customers can still be carried out without interruption. If the Customer needs further
